

12 Essential Scriptures to WIN THE BATTLE OVER YOUR SON

There is a battle over your son, he has a real enemy - one that wants to kill, steal & destroy him (John 10:10). But there is a Master Plan that you can participate in. Use these 12 scriptures as a weapon against the enemy!

1. Create in my son a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within him. -Psalm 51:10
2. My son, serve only the Lord, God, and fear him alone. May you obey His commands, listen to His voice, and cling to Him. -Deuteronomy 13:4
3. My son, be strong and courageous! Do not be afraid and do not panic before anyone. For the Lord your God will personally go ahead of you. He will neither fail you nor abandon you. - Deuteronomy 31:6
4. As for you my son, follow Him, our Lord, with integrity and godliness, as King David did, obeying all His commands, decrees, and regulations. - 1 Kings 9:4
5. My son, don't let anyone think less of you because you are young. Be an example to all believers in what you say, in the way you live, in your love, your faith, and your purity. - 1 Timothy 4:12
6. May my son be taught wisdom's ways and be led in straight and upright paths. - Proverbs 4:11
7. Lord, help my son to not fear the terrors of the night or the arrow that flies by day. - Psalm 91:5
8. Son, honor your father and mother. This is the first commandment with a promise that if you honor your father and mother, things will go well for you, and you will have a long life on the earth. - Ephesians 6:2-4
9. Son, know that the purpose of the Lord's instruction is that all believers will be filled with love that comes from a pure heart, a clear conscience, and genuine faith. - 1 Timothy 1:5
10. Son, by grace may you be saved through faith. And not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of your works, so that you may not boast. - Ephesians 2:8-9
11. I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well. - Psalm 139:14
12. Dear son, one final thing. Fix your thoughts on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise. - Philippians 4:8
